

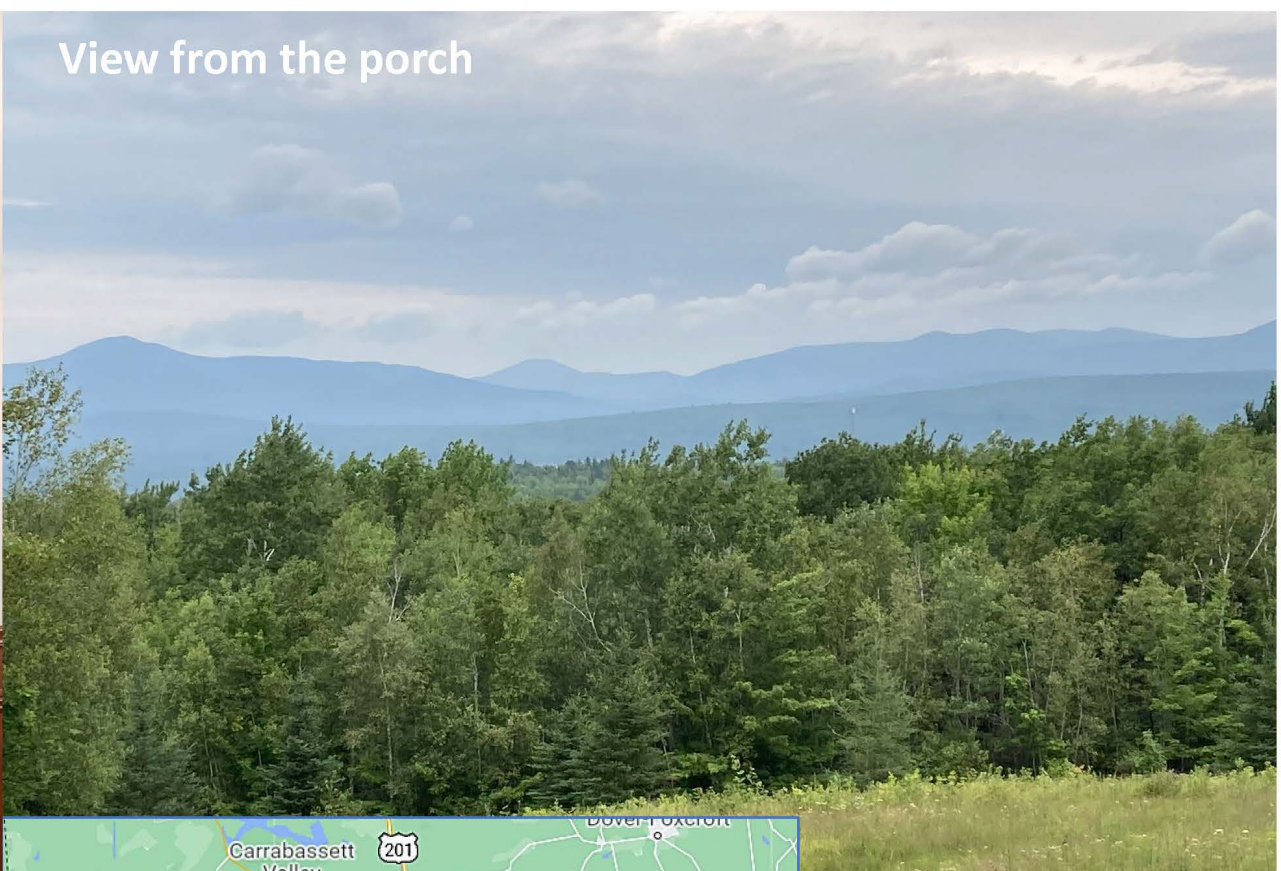
Filling up to two 10-week funded summer internships in Phillips, ME, summer 2023



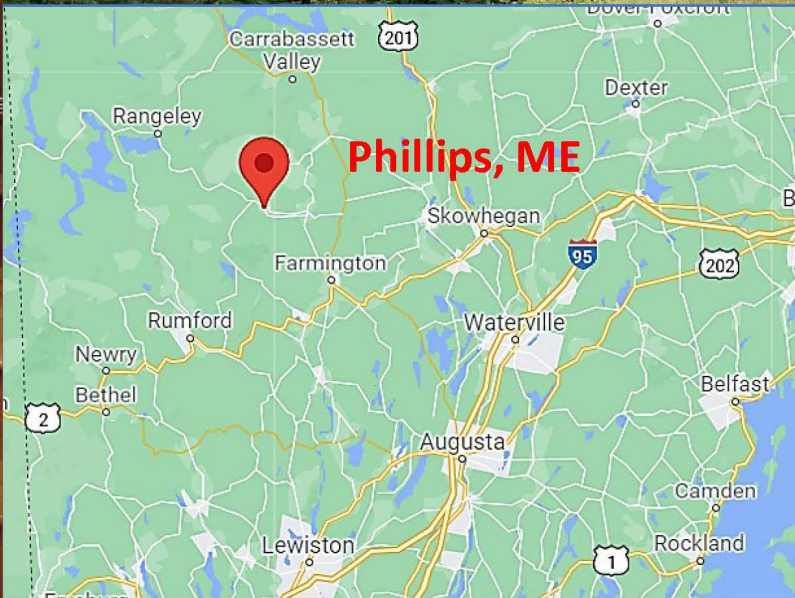




Shared Accommodations

Accommodations

- Up to 2 Conservation internships focused on a collections survey for Firebird Foundation cultural materials: baskets, metalwork, implements collected in Malaysia, 1959-2002. Minor supervised paper treatment possible.
- Currently enrolled graduate students in conservation, objects specialty preferred, are invited to apply
- \$ 8,000 stipend, housing and airfare are also provided, car available for local use
- Shared housing with other interns and with supervisors
- Supervision is live for two weeks, digital for remainder, by Conservators Nicole Passerotti and Ellen Pearlstein
- Work collaboratively with UCLA archival professional and Collections Manager Anne Olivares to promote preservation of the Firebird Archival Collections
- Should be comfortable working in a rural environment and a fieldwork setting
